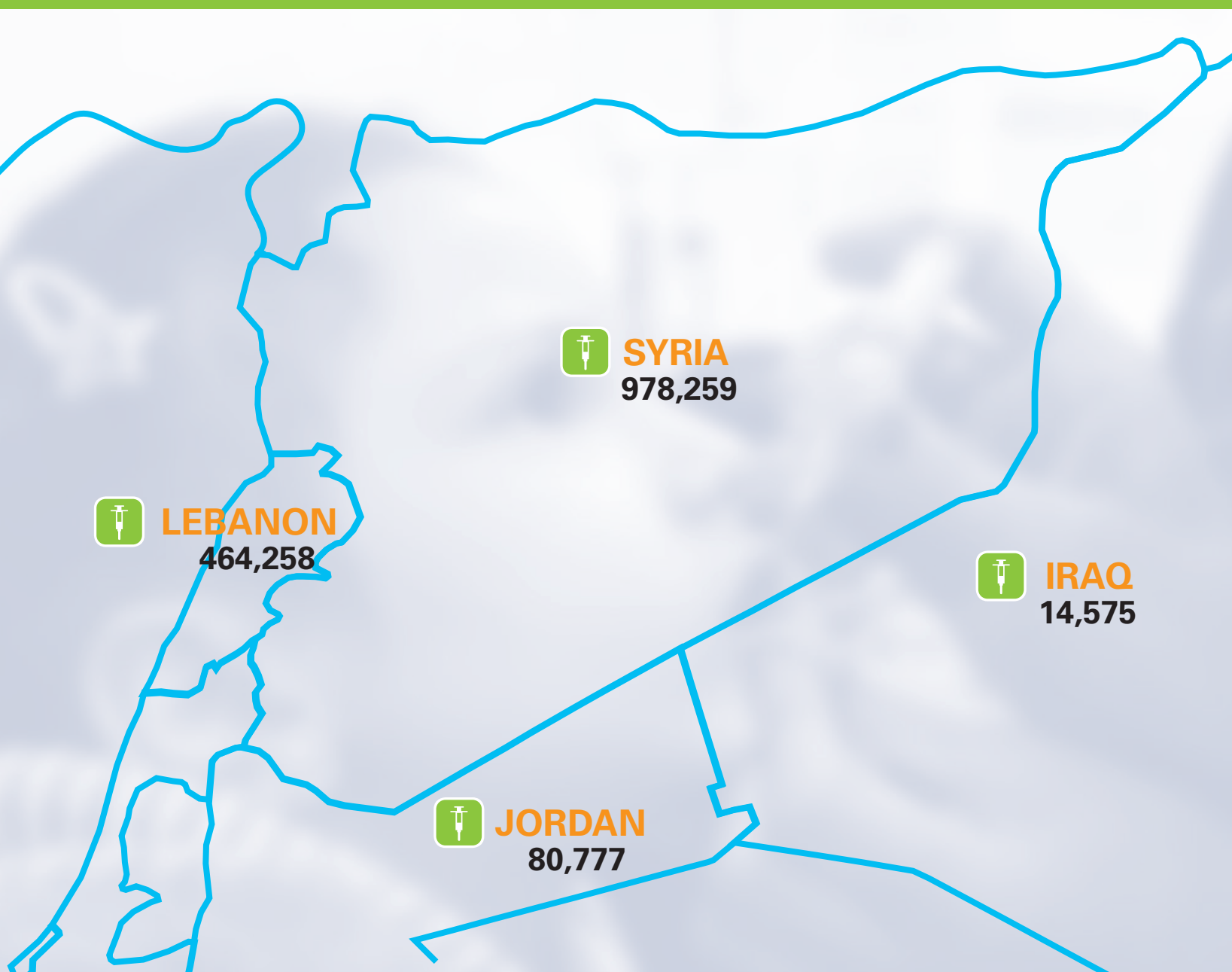


Number of children vaccinated against measles (Total 1.6M)

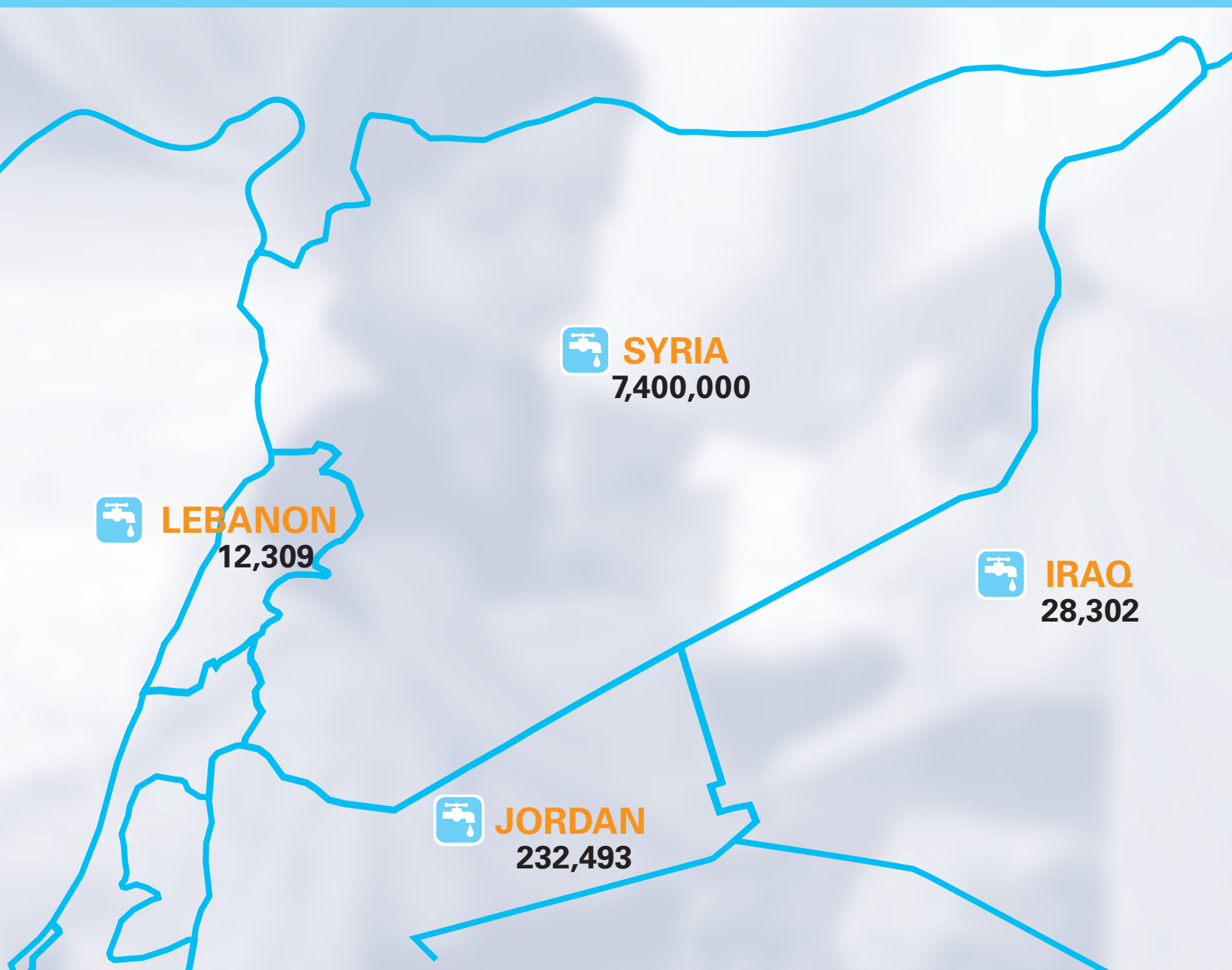

- Rehabilitation and Repairs to Water Systems and Networks.
- Construction and maintenance of sanitation facilities.
- Hygiene items and hygiene awareness.
- Waste management.

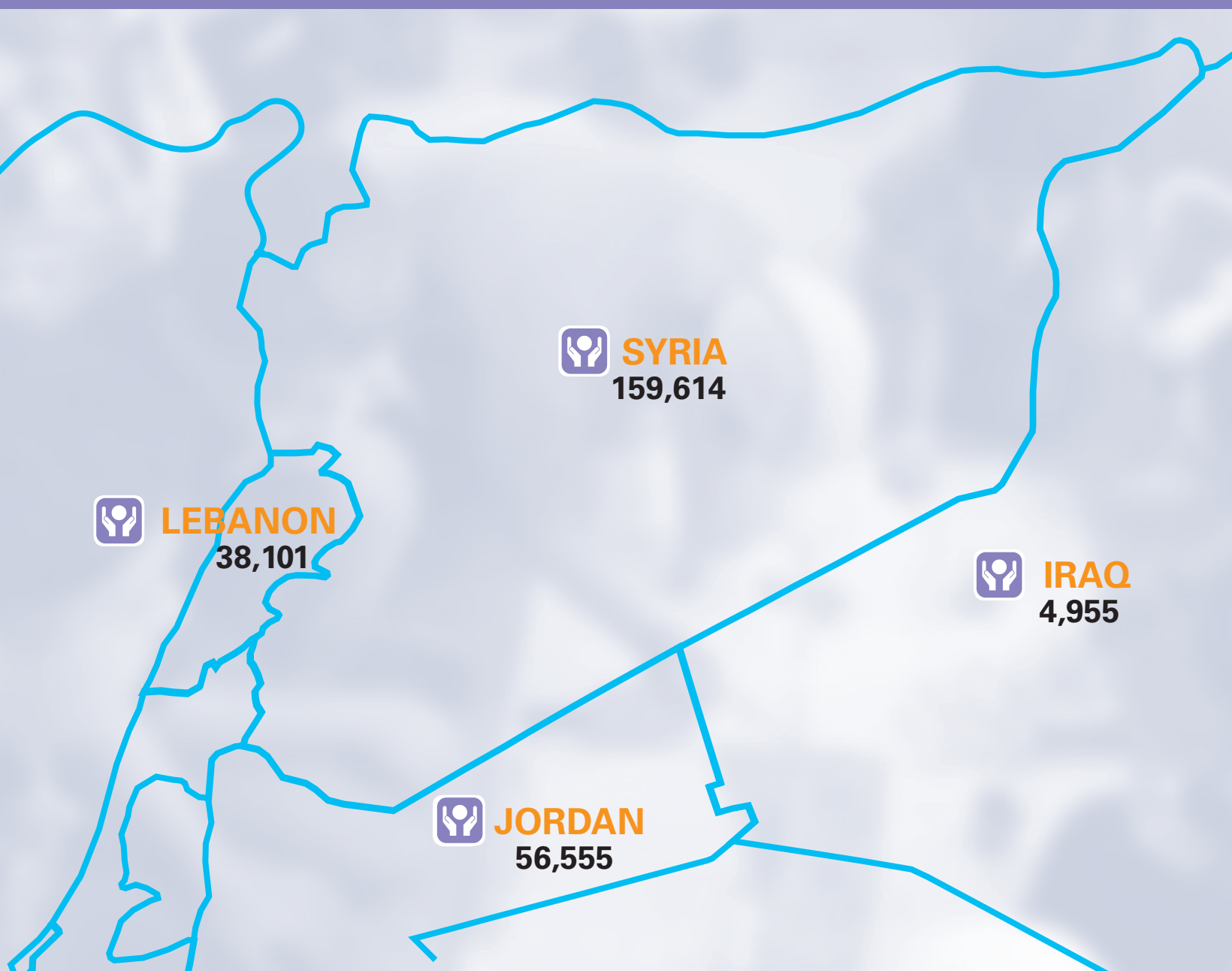
## Education Key Response Activities

- Safe and protective learning spaces.

## Child Protection Key Response Activities

- Psycho-social support through child-friendly and adolescent-friendly spaces.
- Recreational activities, sports, cultural activities and life skills.
- Support communities to provide psychosocial support through training, community based activities and mobile child friendly spaces.
- Education campaigns on dangers of mines, cluster ammunitions and explosive remnants of war.
