

## Saving children's lives with your bequest

It is very simple and easy to include UNICEF Canada as a beneficiary in your Will. Here is sample bequest language that you might like to share with your estate lawyer for possible inclusion:

### SAMPLE BEQUEST LANGUAGE:

I, give, devise and bequeath to the Canadian UNICEF Committee, the sum of \$ \_\_\_\_\_ to be used for any purpose(s) approved by the Board of Directors of the Canadian UNICEF Committee.

I, give, devise and bequeath to the Canadian UNICEF Committee \_\_\_\_\_ percentage of the residue of my estate to be used for any purpose(s) approved by the Board of Directors of the Canadian UNICEF Committee.

Upon the death of the survivor of my (wife, husband, etc.) \_\_\_\_\_ and my (son, daughter, etc.) \_\_\_\_\_ I direct my trustee to transfer and deliver the balance of the residue of my estate, including any undistributed income to the Canadian UNICEF Committee to be used for any purpose(s) approved by the Board of Directors of the Canadian UNICEF Committee.
