Data Integration Developer

Reporting to the Manager, Business Intelligence, the Data Integration Developer is responsible for ensuring UNICEF Canada has access to high quality Business Intelligence data to drive revenue growth and enhance supporter engagement. This is achieved through a range of data integration and data management functions, as well as bringing data in and out of our Raiser's Edge (RE) constituent relationship management (CRM) system.

The responsibilities of the position will include:

Designing and implementing data integration solutions (50%)

- Understanding the business needs of data stakeholders to support new Business Intelligence projects to meet changing business/technical requirements.
- Implementing new or enhanced processes using SQL, SSIS and C#/VBA coding.
- Developing and carrying out testing plans for all new and enhanced processes.

Overseeing, maintaining and troubleshooting all existing data integration solutions (35%)

- Automate 2-way data integration between Raiser's Edge and our Engaging Networks online fundraising platform.
- Ensure business processes preserve data integrity to meet business goals.
- Daily fundraising data imports into Raiser's Edge through ImportOmatic.
- Import and export processes to integrate data with fundraising vendors.



User support (5%)

- Provide support to the gift processing team on existing data integration, data entry and import processes.
- Provide training to gift processing team on how to run data integration, data entry and import processes.

Developing and maintaining documentation on all data integration processes (5%)

Maintaining the SQL Server applications and provide DBA-type support (5%)
