

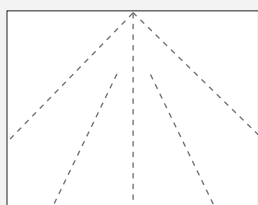
#GOBLUE AIRPLANE FOR CHILDREN ACROSS THE COUNTRY AND AROUND THE WORLD

HOW TO MAKE

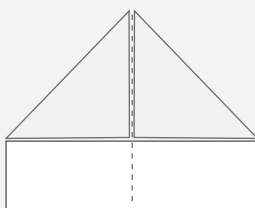
Instructions: Print the following page double-sided in colour or black and white and follow the instructions below

- 1 Fold the piece of paper in half lengthwise

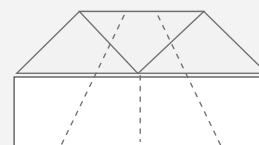


This side up

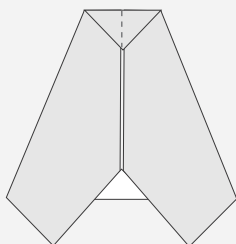
- 2 Flatten paper, grab top right corner and fold towards the crease to make a triangle, then do the same with the left corner



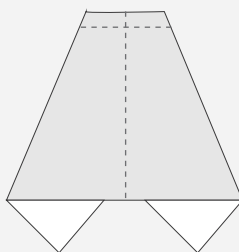
- 3 Fold top point of triangle down



- 4 Fold the top left corner toward the centre to form a long triangle, and repeat for the left side



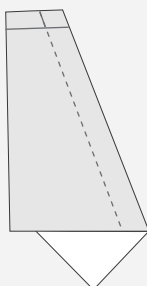
- 5 Flip page over and fold down the top towards you



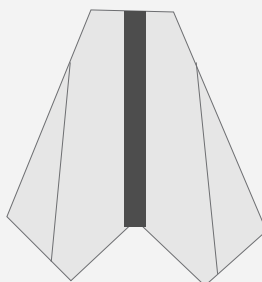
- 6 Fold the paper in half along the centre line (this is the original centre line from step 1)

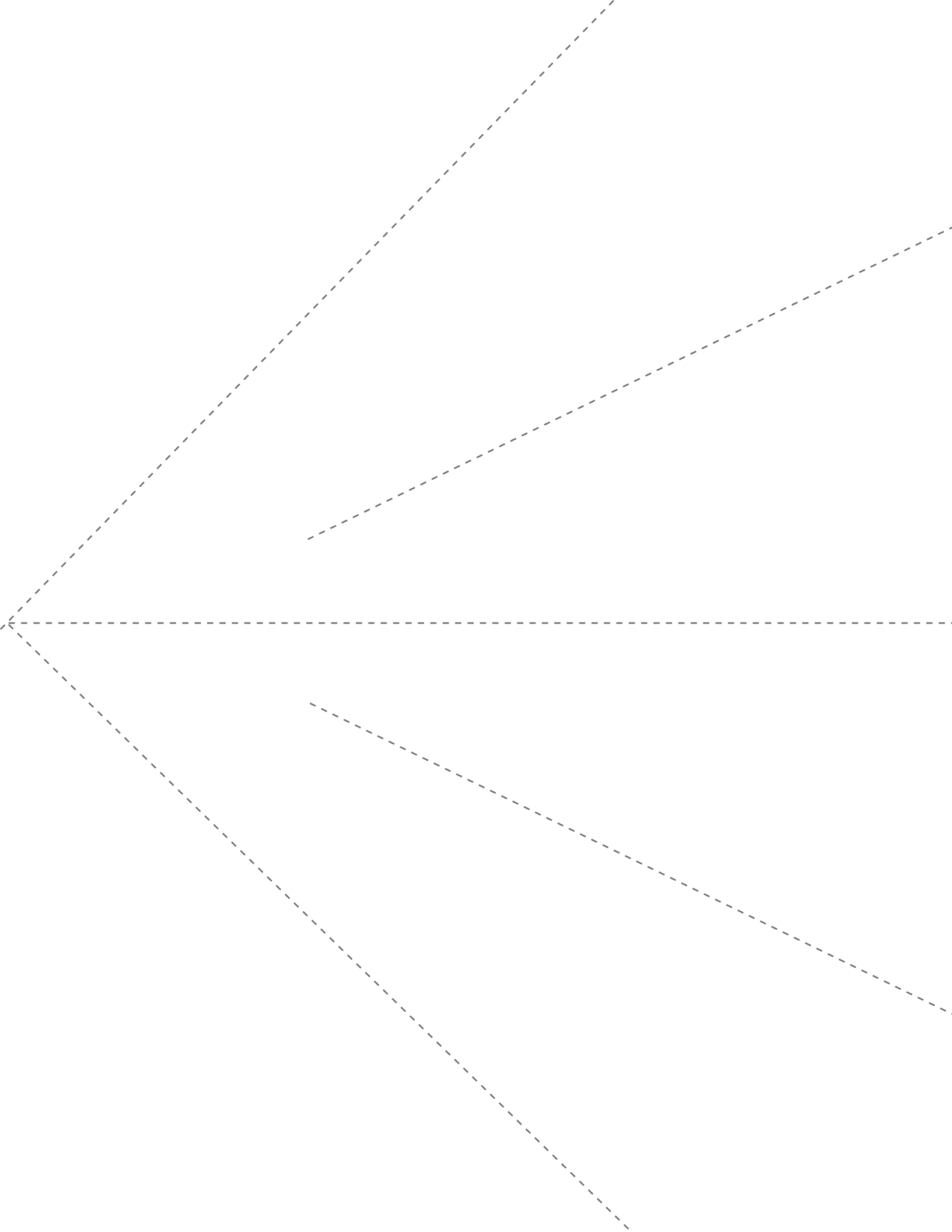


- 7 Crease each angled side toward the centre fold to create the airplane wings



- 8 Once both sides have been creased, unfold slightly so the plane is flat on top
