

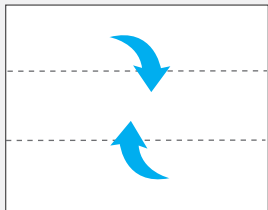
#GOBLUE PAPER PUPPET SHOW FOR CHILDREN'S RIGHTS

Put on a paper puppet show to talk about children's rights! Need help giving your puppet a script? Take a look at the **Convention of the Rights of the Child** to get familiar with your rights. Pick a right and use your puppet to explain it to the audience and why it's important to you!

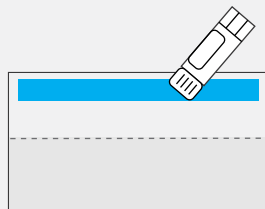
HOW TO MAKE

Instructions: Print this page in colour or black and white and follow the instructions

- Fold a piece of paper into thirds lengthwise. First take one side of the paper and fold it a third, then from the opposite side fold it a third so it goes overtop



- Glue the top flap down and rub flat



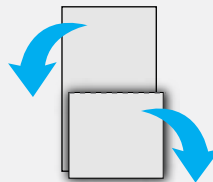
- Rotate the paper so it is vertical and fold the rectangle in half



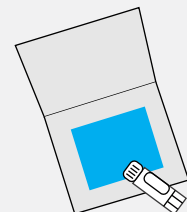
- Fold the rectangle in half again



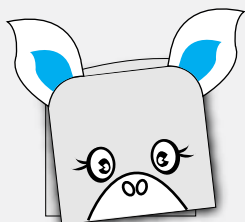
- Fold each flap from the half rectangle so the edges line up with centre fold (if you gently pull apart from each end, the paper forms the letter M)



- Glue the outsides down (leaving the centre unglued)



- You can now colour in eyes, nose, mouth on the top side of your puppet



- Place your fingers in the openings to use your puppet
