A look back...

30 years supporting children's rights through the UNICEF Water for Life Gala

1993

The first Chefs for UNICEF Gala is held at The Westin with 300 guests in attendance, raising \$125,000.



1999

The event moves to the Sheraton Eau Claire and the Gala cummulatively raises almost \$1M.



2000

Veronica Tennant participates as the first guest speaker and this year the event raises \$150,000.



2001

The Gala moves to the Hyatt Regency Calgary, and Honorary Chair Jim Gray forms the first Patrons Council to help sell tables and ensure the long-term success of the event.



2003



UNICEF Goodwill Ambassador Sir Roger Moore attends the Gala as the guest speaker and the event raises almost \$300,000 for girls' education, early childhood development, immunization, HIV/AIDS and child protection.

2005

The Gala receives a \$250,000 matching donation with over \$900,000 raised for children affected by HIV/ AIDS in Mozambique.



2009

The Gala raises \$670,000 to improve the nutrition and health of tens of thousands of Guatemalan children.









Chefs for UNICEF becomes UNICEF Water for Life Gala and Chantal Kreviazuk performs at the event. The \$770,000 raised during the Gala supported 24,000 people living in 19 remote villages in the Democratic Republic of the Congo, to gain improved access to safe drinking water and live in a cholera-free environment.

2012



Clav Aiken introduces the sale of water pumps at the 20th anniversary of the Gala, selling 169 pumps in 10 minutes. The Gala raises \$845,000 to create safe, clean school environments that help improve learning outcomes. This project helped 22,500 students in 45 schools, and provided 34 water tanks, 8,000 jerry cans, and water purification tablets for 9.000 families.

2015

The Gala raised \$968,000, out of which \$185,000 was raised using electronic bidding for



the first time. These funds supported water facilities in 21 health centres in Ghana, creating sanitary conditions for healthcare workers and reducing maternal and newborn deaths.

2017



Sarah McLachlan performs at the 25th Anniversary of the UNICEF Water for Life Gala celebrating 25 years of Calgary support for children, with \$13M+ raised.

2020

The Gala shifts to an online auction due to the COVID-19 pandemic, raising \$77,300.



2021

A Virtual Gala & Online Auction take place, bringing the 29-year cumulative fundraising total to more than \$16 million.



2022

The UNICEF Water for Life Gala is hosted in person again, celebrating its 30th anniversary and the impact the Calgary community has had in the lives of children. raising over \$18M since 1993.
